

SETTING-UP AT SOUTHILL

Some of you looking at this website may not have played Short Mat and wonder how it is set-up. Designed to be played in small halls, Village Halls and Community Centres where it is played each have their own method of storage and set-up. This is the way we do it at Southill. A founder member of our club when it came into being constructed a 3 compartment storage unit at one end of our hall where all the equipment for the mats could be safely kept.



One mat on a roller is housed in each compartment with its fenders, foot mats, block and score board. The wheeled roller is taken out of its compartment the mat placed in position and rolled out.



When each mat is in place with all its equipment in situ play begins.



Play over, mats go back on their rollers and are put away leaving the hall free for other users.
